SUBJECT: Follow-up on commitments made at the meeting in Paris

Dear Maria

I hope that you have now received the report of the meeting and you have discussed this initiative with your colleagues and other organisations within your own networks.

I would now like to follow-up on the commitments you made at the meeting and investigate how we can transform these into concrete contributions to CRIN. Firstly, I would like to confirm that the commitments are still appropriate and realistic. Secondly I would like to know how you would like to take these forward and lastly, I would like to know if there are any further contributions that you would like to make.

1. At the meeting in Paris PIDEE offered to contribute to the organisations database. How do you think this is best managed? Do you envisage providing information on your contacts, would this be in hard or electronic formats, would you want to be involved in updating the database for Chile - depending on what this involves?

2. Most organisations at the meeting offered to provide information on issues of special interest and access to their own publications. Does PIDEE have other specialist information collections and resources which would be useful to participants of the network? If so, what is the best way of disseminating these resources? Do you produce issue specific reference listings which may be of interest to other participants? Does PIDEE produce its own newsletters which would be useful and interesting to participants? Do you think it would be useful to disseminate PIDEE's annual report to network participants? (I would certainly like to have a copy as I am building up reference profiles of all the participants?)

3. PIDEE also offered to be involved in training activities. What would your contribution be - running training courses, developing training materials for information handling on the Rights of the Child etc?

4. Are there any other contributions which you feel PIDEE could make to the network eg involvement in any of the proposed projects, support to funding activities, access to PIDEE's documentation centre, acting as a focal point for Chile?

Finally, I have created a mailing list of the participants in Wordperfect 5.1, this file can be used for multiple communications by letter and fax. Would you like me to send you a copy on diskette?
